

*Lake George Club
Junior Program Disciplinary Procedure*

All Junior participants have agreed to abide by the LGC's Code of Conduct. If in the opinion of the LGC's General Manager, Junior Coordinator, Tennis Chair, or Commodore, a Junior participant is in violation of the COC, the LGC reserves the right to invoke the following three step disciplinary process.

Step 1. If there is a violation of the COC the Jr. participant's parents/guardian will be advised of the violation and a written or verbal warning will be given to the Jr. participant and parents/guardian.

Step 2. If there is a second violation of the COC after the warning has been given, the Jr. participant will be dismissed from the Junior Program for 1 week, and during that week will not be allowed on LGC grounds when the Jr. Program activities are in session.

Step 3. If there is a third violation of the COC, the Junior participant will be dismissed from the Junior Program for the remainder of the summer and not allowed on the LGC grounds when Junior Program activities are in session.

Dismissals from the Junior Program and exclusion from LGC grounds under steps 1 or 2 will be authorized by the LGC General Manager, Junior Coordinator, Tennis Chair, Commodore, or LGC President. Appeals from such dismissals and exclusions may be made to the LGC Executive Committee in writing. Pending any decision by the LGC Executive Committee on such appeal, the dismissal and exclusion shall remain in effect.

Notwithstanding anything in Steps 1-3, when, in the view of the Club Manager, Junior Coordinator or LGC President, the conduct of the participant poses a danger to the safety of the participant, any other person, or LGC property, or shows a manifest disrespect to any instructor, the LGC General Manager, the Junior Coordinator, the Commodore, the Tennis Chair, or any LGC Officer, the Club Manager, or Junior Coordinator, or LGC President, may immediately dismiss or suspend the participant from the Junior Program and/or exclude the participant from LGC grounds, for a period of time deemed reasonable in the sole discretion of the person issuing the dismissal, suspension, or exclusion. Appeals from such dismissal, suspension, or exclusion may be made to the LGC Executive Committee in writing. Pending any decision by the LGC Executive Committee on such appeal, the dismissal and exclusion shall remain in effect.
